GASTLOSENEXPRESS CHAIRLIFT/ STATION MUSERBERGLI (S)



The snowshoe trail runs from the Musersbergli station to the panoramic area. Then a slight descent begins, followed by a climb to the Soldatenhaus (soldier's chalet) at the foot of the Gastlosen Mountains.

The Gastlosenexpress takes you to an altitude of 1540 metres, with a view of the peaks overlooking the villages of Jaun and Im Fang. The trail starts its way to the panoramic area in the shadow of the Gratflue.

The imposing presence of the Gastlosen chain will join you throughout the climb up to the Soldatenhaus. The limestone cliffs are also known as the "Swiss Dolomites". One of the mountains has a hole in it, called the "Grossmutterloch". According to legend, the devil was angry with his grandmother and smashed her against the cliff. With some luck, you may see a unique light show. You can admire the sun piercing through the hole at several points along the trial from the Gross Rüggli to the Unterer Sattel.

The trail goes through the forest to the Alp Oberer Sattel. A superb view awaits you at the foot of the Gastlosen. The Klein Mungtal nestles at its feet. The descent leads down to the sledge run or the Sommer Wanderweg from the Oberen to the Unteren Sattel. After the Buvette des Sattels, the trail goes through the wood to the village of Jaun.

This unprepared itinerary is marked. You take this trail at your own risk. Snowshoeing is done in the mountains, therefore, certain rules must be respected for your safety.
