



TERMS OF CANCELLATION TREKKING OFFERS

1. LA BERRA OFFER

Gîte d'Allières

If the reservation is cancelled within 24 hours of the time of reservation, half of the total price will be invoiced.

2. OFFER THE ADVENTURER

Hotel Wasserfall

No cancellation fee 7 days before arrival. 50% of the total price for hotel services is due up to 3 days before arrival. In the event of late cancellation, i.e. 3 days before the stay, the full amount is charged.

Chalet du soldat

Cancellation is possible 72 hours before the scheduled date of the stay due to really bad weather conditions. Light rain during the day does not constitute bad weather conditions.

Cancellations made less than 72 hours before the scheduled date will be charged up to 50% of the total cost of the stay.

3. CABIN OFFER

Chalet du soldat

Cancellation is possible 72 hours before the scheduled date of stay for really bad weather. Light rain during the day does not constitute bad weather.

Cancellations made less than 72 hours before the scheduled date will result in a fee of up to 50% of the total cost of the stay.

Cabane des Marindes

In case of cancellation less than 48 hours before the scheduled date of stay, the full amount will be charged to the client.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS TREKKING OFFERS

1. LA BERRA OFFER

Gîte d'Allières

Pets are not allowed in the rooms. There is the possibility to have them sleep in a separate room.

The opening hours are as follows: Close at 11 pm, breakfast 7.30 am - 9 am, evening meal from 6 pm.

Allergies must be mentioned on the booking form if, for example, gluten-free bread is required.

Arrival times must be no later than 8 pm.

2. OFFER THE ADVENTURER

Hôtel Wasserfall

The kitchen is usually open from 6 pm to 9 pm and from 6 pm to 7 pm on Sunday, Wednesday and Thursday.

Dogs are welcome for CHF 15 per night.

Extra bed CHF 30 per night



Chalet du soldat

For organisation, guests are asked to arrive no later than 6.30 pm.

The evening meal is served at 7.30 pm

Allergies or vegetarian diet requirements need to be announced at least 24 hours before arrival (no vegans meals available)

The chalet does not have shower facilities.
